A Freeman of the Goldsmith's Company and a Freeman of the City of London, he is the author of Starting to Collect Antique Jewellery and co-author with Paul Atterbury of Arts and Crafts to Art Deco; The Jewellery and Silver of H.G Murphy. A Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries, he was a regular contributor for over 30 years to BBC Antiques Roadshow.

John was appointed The National Trust's Honorary Jewellery Adviser in 2021 and is currently in the process of curating the Trust's entire collection of jewellery, gems and Faberge.
